
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*Data include all disability decisions completed in FY2008 and include claims that were filed in FY06 or prior years. These are decisions on disability eligibility. Other non-disability eligibility fectors may affect final eligibility for benofits , i.e., some cases with a favorable disability decision could ultimately be denied for failure to meet other eligibility requirements. Some disability claims not eligible on non-disability grounds will not be referred for a disability decision and are not reflected in the data shown. Decisions include Title II - Social Security Disability Insurance and Title XVI - Supplemental Security Income (SSI) cases. Some claimants may file concurrently for both Title II and Title XVI. Concurrent Title II/XVI cases are counted as one.

Approximately 24% of initial level dentals are from 10 states using the Prototype process. If appealed, these cases would bypeas the reconsideration level and go directly to an Administrative Law Judge hearing.
